

# **SCHOLARSHIPS FOR NEW STUDENTS**

## **Servant Leaders' Scholarship**

This full-tuition, renewable scholarship is awarded to as many as six first-time freshmen a year. Students may compete for this scholarship with a cumulative GPA of 3.75 or higher and a minimum ACT Test Composite of 25 or a minimum SAT test score of 1100 (critical reading, math score). Qualified applicants not receiving this award may be awarded the Pierson Missionary Leaders' or the President's Scholarship. Recipients are required to live on campus and dine in the dining hall, work each week in service to the institution, and be active in student life.

## **Pierson Missionary Leaders' Scholarship**

This \$6,000, renewable scholarship is based on meeting two of the following three criteria; rank in the top 15% of graduating class or 3.75 GPA or 25 ACT/1100 SAT (critical reading, math score). Homeschooled students must meet both GPA and test scores. Pierson scholars will support missionaries through prayer, encouragement, or through direct mission opportunities locally, nationally, or abroad.

## **Project 032 Scholarship**

If you have a passion for community outreach mission work and showing the love of Christ through service to others, you may be eligible to receive one of 20 exclusive \$2000 scholarships. To be considered, please complete the Project 032 Scholarship application including descriptions of previous community service experience and an essay about your ambition to serve the community. The scholarships are awarded on a first-come, first served basis. Applicants are encouraged to apply early for the best chance of receiving a Project 032 Scholarship.

## **Transfer Honor Scholarship**

This \$4,000, renewable scholarship is available to incoming students who have achieved a cumulative GPA of 3.7 or higher with 24 or more hours of transfer credit.

## **President's Scholarship**

This \$3,000, renewable scholarship is available to a limited number of incoming students who have achieved a cumulative GPA of at least a 3.65. Home school students are additionally awarded based on an ACT score of 24 or higher or an SAT score of 1050 (critical reading, math score) or higher. The student must also be involved in community, church, and or other extracurricular activities.

## **Dean's Scholarship**

This \$2,000, renewable scholarship is available to a limited number of incoming students who have achieved a cumulative GPA of 3.5. Home school students are additionally awarded on an ACT score of 23 or higher or an SAT score (critical reading, math score) of 1000 or higher. The student must be involved in community, church, and other extracurricular activities.

## **Excellence Scholarship**

This \$1,500, renewable scholarship is available to a limited number of incoming students who have achieved a cumulative GPA of 3.0. Home-schooled students are additionally awarded on an ACT score of 21 or higher or an SAT score (critical reading, math score) of 900 or higher. The student must be involved in community, church, and other extracurricular activities.

## Church Matching

This “Up to \$6,000”, renewable scholarship originates in your home church. SWC will match church contribution dollar for dollar, up to \$6,000 per year. Renewal requires continued financial support and satisfactory academic performance. You may choose between the Church Matching Scholarship and any other scholarship for which you may qualify. Recipients are committed to working at their respective churches while earning a degree at Southwestern College.

## Heart & Seoul Gospel Ministries Scholarship

This \$3,000 stackable and renewable scholarship is awarded to a student with a desire to minister to people of Korean heritage. Applicants must fill out an application and interview with representatives of Heart & Seoul Ministries, and reapply each year. A 3.0 GPA is required to be eligible for this scholarship.

## AWANA Scholarship Citation Award

This \$3,000, stackable and renewable scholarship requires a verification letter from AWANA headquarters along with satisfactory academic progress.

This \$2,000, stackable and renewable scholarship requires a verification letter from AWANA headquarters along with satisfactory academic progress.

## Music Scholarships

These audition-based annual scholarships are awarded to students who demonstrate exceptional music talent. Vocal and instrumental scholarships are available and awarded on an audition-basis only. Contact the Music Department for complete details.

## Alumni Scholarship

Dependent children of Southwestern College graduates who have completed a Bachelor degree are eligible to receive a \$1,400 scholarship that will be divided equally between the fall and spring semesters. This scholarship is stackable and renewable.

## Christian Workers Scholarship

This \$1,400 scholarship is available to full-time students who are dependent family members of active pastors, church staff, missionaries, Christian school employees, and other workers in full-time ministry. This scholarship is stackable and renewable and a confirmation letter from ministry is required.

## Multi-Ethnic & Minority Scholarship

This \$1,000 to \$2,000, stackable and renewable scholarship is based on demonstrated financial need and is renewable with satisfactory academic progress. A 2.0 GPA is required to be eligible for this scholarship.

## Multiple Student Scholarship

This \$1,400, stackable and renewable scholarship is available when two or more immediate family members are enrolled concurrently at Southwestern College. A 2.0 GPA is required to be eligible for this scholarship.

## Adult Learner Ministry Grant

Students for this grant are at least 23 years of age, are following a call from their church to prepare for full-time church ministry (letter required), and can only attend part-time. Students who meet these criteria are eligible to receive a \$175 grant (reduction in tuition) for each credit hour taken per semester.

## Southwestern College Grant

This variable grant is awarded to students who demonstrate financial need and have achieved a GPA of 2.0 or higher. Renewal of this grant is not automatic and is subject to available funding.
